For the 2026 competition season EMGC will offer two competition series. This will allow riders to track points in two separate series. The first series will include the events May 2 – August 2 and the second series will start August 29 and continue to the end of the season.

The goal is to encourage riders to compete in a division that best suits their skills, while ensuring the integrity of divisions are maintained. In addition, this will ensure that riders are rewarded for their hard work and dedication to their skills development. Each series will award high-point and reserve high-point in each division. This will allow riders to graduate to the next level in-season and all riders will start with a new points tally for the second series.

Riders will be encouraged to graduate and move to the ‘next’ level between series to ensure that division standards are maintained. This will allow for fair and safe play for all. Riders will be encouraged to ‘move up’ to the next level by the referees of their division if they surpass the abilities, pace, and skillset of their division.

Example: A rider is competing in the Novice Division at the start of the season (Go & Grow Series May 2 -1 August 2) and their skills noticeably improve, allowing them to surpass the division skillset and pace. This pony-rider combination will be encouraged to move up to the Intermediate division for the second series of the season (Rise & Shine Series Aug 29 to end of season).
